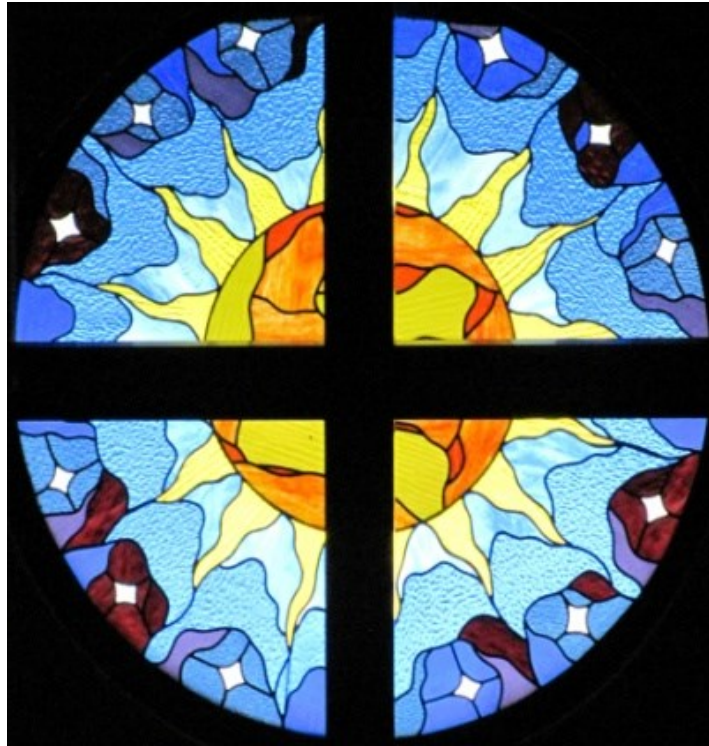

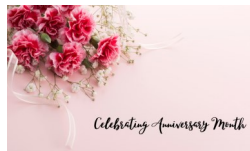

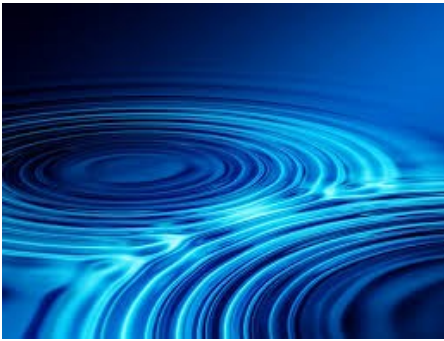

July 2024 – God’s Work, Our Hands

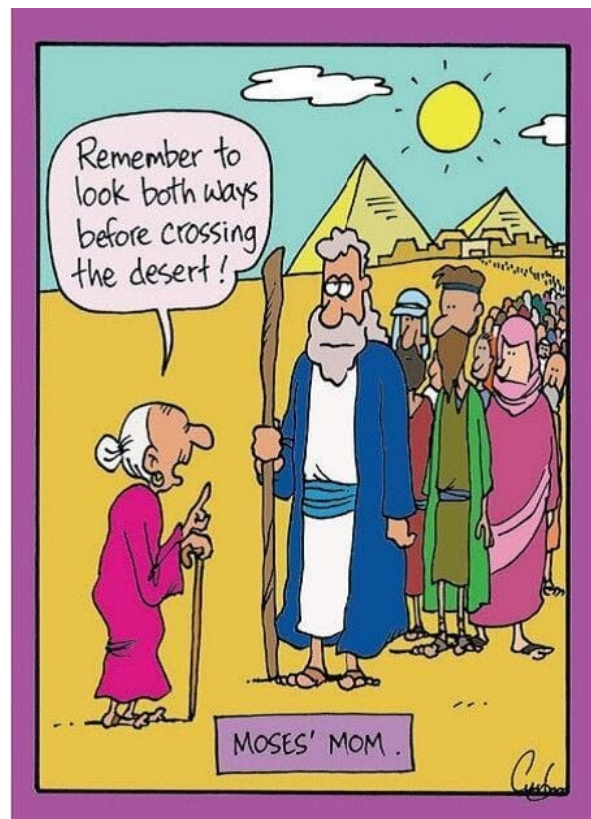
It’s nearly that time of year again – God’s Work, Our Hands! Though the official day is in September, it’s not too late to plan how your congregation can engage with GWOH Day.

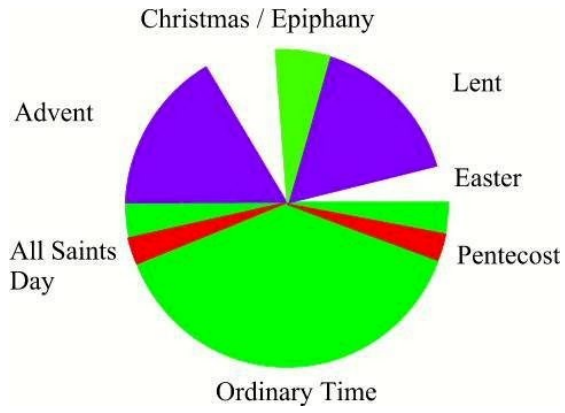


The church office will be closed on Thursday, July 4th. Have a safe and happy 4th of July!!

What is Ordinary Time in the Lutheran church?

The rest of the year following Pentecost is known as Ordinary Time, from the word "ordinal," which simply means counted time (First Sunday after Pentecost, etc.). June 23rd was the 5th Sunday after Pentecost. Check out our monthly calendar to follow along with the liturgical year.
