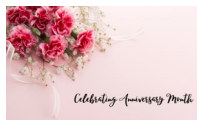

These are important issues to deal with to ensure a healthy congregation, in which there are no power struggles or expectations of special treatment.

Let us move forward. There are options out there for clergy, but it all depends on you, my friends. All in all, there is a great congregation with much potential.

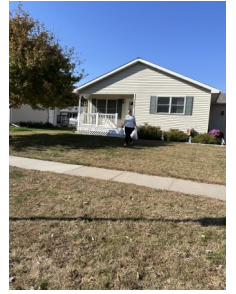
